

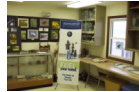
Junior Conservationist Day Camp

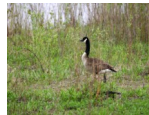
Education Center

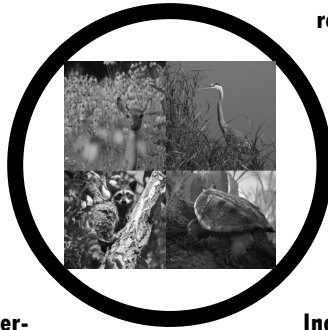
